International guarantee

Starting on the date of purchase entered on this certificate, a five-year international guarantee covers Imhof watches against manufacturing defects that affect the proper functioning of the watch itself (movement, case, dial, hands, crown, push-button and crystal).

During the warranty period and upon presentation of the valid warranty certificate, you are entitled to have any defect repaired free of charge. If your lmhof watch cannot be repaired to normal operating conditions, Imhof will replace it with an identical Imhof watch or one with similar characteristics.

Usual garantee *limits*

Any repairs we may need to carry out as a result of the following will be invoiced in all cases (following your signed acceptance of the quotation), including during the guarantee period.

Observed damage arising from incorrect use or serious negligence (major impacts, crushing, broken crystal) or any damage arising from unjustifiable modifications or repairs.

Observe damage from fire, acid or natual disasters

Damage resulting from prolonged exposure to extreme conditions (such as temperatures above 60°C or below -10°C) will be observed.

Aesthetic changes due to wear and tear or normal aging (such as minor scratches on the case or glass, or changes in the color of the case or strap) are not included in this warranty.

The warranty may not be honored if the point of sale and date of purchase are unclear, illegible, or have been altered on the guarantee certificate, or if the guarantee certificate is not provided with the watch.

Any component of the watch, including the case, crown, push-button, hands, dial, glass, strap, buckle, the complete movement, or any part thereof, may be replaced with substitute components if the original parts are no longer available.



Water resistance to 100 m (10 atm)

The entire Arthur collection is waterresistant to a depth of 100 meters, meaning they can withstand pressure equivalent to immersionin water up to 10 ATM.

When using the watch in a wet environment, always ensure that the winding crown is in its original position (manual winding position, 01) to maintain effective water resistance.

Recommended Maintenance Schedule:

It is advisable to have your watch, at least, inspected regularly by a qualified watchmaker or an authorized after-sales service center.

Ideally, the water resistance should be checked every two years, and the overall operation and functions every five years.






Movement

Mechanical movement with automatic winding by a ball-bearing-mounted central oscillating rotor

Functions



The crown has three positions

- 1. Neutral position
- 2. Date-correction position
- 3. Time-setting position

Starting the watch

Crown in position 1. This position enables you to restart the self-winding movement manually by turning he crown upwards.

Correcting the date

Pull the crown out to position 2. Turn the crown downwards until the required date (D).

Setting the time

Pull the crown out to position 3. Turn the crown upwards to move the hands (A,B,C) to the required tie. For accurate time-setting, ensure that the last adjustment of the hands is made in a clockwise direction. After this operation, push the crown back to position I. Turn the crown downwards to make sure it turns freely.

Important note

When in the time-setting position, do not turn the crown downwards.

It is indispensable to set the watch to time before making the date correction.

Important note

Important note: Once the time-setting is complete, the date correction must not under any circumstances be done while the watch shows the time between 11 pm and 4 am.

Important note

To restore your crown to its watertight position, you need to press on the crown while screwing it in. We advise you to check that it is firmly in place before use.

Kindly remember


This watch is guaranteed water-resistant to 10 bar (100 meters), provided the crown is in position 1.



Strap *adjustment*

The strap on Arthur watches can be adjusted without the need for tools.

The IMHOF shield is a button you can press to adjust the strap to your wrist.



First step


Press the IMHOF shield (A) to release the strap.

Second step

Keep the button (A) depressed, and adjust your strap to the position you want (O (B) to 6 (C)), there are 6 positions available so that your watch fits perfectly on your wrist.

Third step

Release the button (A) to set your strap to the right position.
